Town offers non-emergency reporting process

Ocean City's Citizen Problem Reporter can be used by the general public to submit non-emergency problems or requests for service in our town.

Users can anonymously submit new requests, review existing requests, and comment on requests submitted by other users.

To report a problem or request assistance for a service, go to www.oceancitymd.gov and click on Citizen Reporter.

Sign up for OC Alert notifications

OC Alert, powered by Smart911, is a free service that allows individuals to sign up for notifications sent from state and local

authorities. OC Alert keeps residents and travelers informed on potentially hazardous situations involving weather, traffic and other emergencies.

To receive OC Alert notifications, go to www.oceancitymd.gov/oc/alerts to register. Notifications can be sent via text, email and/or a phone call, depending on which you choose. You can also download the Smart911 application to your mobile device. Alerts include severe weather watches and warnings, evacuation orders, safety risks, vehicle accidents and town notifications.

Caine Woods history

Street names have changed over the years

Did you know...

- Your home's address could be Gorman Avenue instead of 136th Street.
- Or it could be Roosevelt Avenue instead of 138th Street.
- What was Bennett Avenue is now 139th Street.
- And what was Kenworthy Avenue is now 140th Street.
- Lea Avenue is now 141st Street.
- Frankford Avenue is now 142nd Street.

- Stockley Avenue is now 143rd Street.
- Taylor Avenue is now 144th Street.
- Whaley Avenue is now 146th Street.

These street names were changed to numbered streets in the mid-1960s, after Ocean City's town limits were extended from 41st Street to the Delaware state line.






