To prevent the abuse of unused prescription medication, the Ocean City Police Department has a drug drop box in the lobby of the Public Safety Building at 65th Street bayside.

Most prescription medicines should not be flushed down the toilet or thrown into the trash. This drop box program allows residents and visitors to dispose of unneeded, expired or unwanted medicine easily and properly.

Directors were Howard Caplan, Liz Dare, Irene Hansen, Lucille Johansen, Joe Kostelac, Agnes Schaper, Rosalie Stuller, Donna Umbel. Liz Dare was newsletter editor, and the audit was performed by Ann Gough.

Hurricane Irene in August forced the cancelation of our end-of-summer picnic and general membership meeting.

At the September meeting of the CWCA board of directors, it was decided to email the membership to vote on the slate of officers and a bylaw change. Both were approved.

A representative of Delmarva Power spoke at the October board meeting on its plans to expand the 138th Street substation, with an installation of a static VAR compensator. It will improve electric reliability.

The annual Christmas caroling event was held on the second Tuesday of December. Members delighted children with a visit from Santa and cheered up

homebound members with holiday music.

Our charity crab feast at Higgins Crab House North raised \$3,700 for the Cricket Center, a child advocacy center in Worcester County.

We held our annual Fiesta Park cleanup April 14 with help from a crew and supplies from the Ocean City Recreation and Parks Department.

This spring, we lost two active members of the Caine Woods Community: Bob LeMay and Dan Smith.




